
EVERYDAY WILDLIFE

Eagles and osprey are frequent overhead, while moose, the occasional black bear, beavers, marmots, and minks visit the riverbank. Ducks raise their ducklings along the shore, and in winter, you might spot river otters popping up through the ice. Finches and hummingbirds round out the backyard bird-watching.
