

## Hampton Station Pool Rules – 2025 Effective 04/29/2024 REVISED 04/29/2024

- 1. The pool hours are 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM.
- 2. The pool and facilities are for members in good standing and their guest resident. **Guests are limited to 6 per occasion.**
- **3.** Community pool parties and community or private events that originate include the pool, must be approved by the Board. A Maximum of 20 gue reserved by the Amenities Director.
- 4. Glass is not allowed in the pool or on the deck.
- 5. No Smoking or Vaping is permitted in the pool, on the deck or at the cl
- 6. Children that are not fully potty trained **MUST** wear swim diapers.
- 7. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older) at all t
- 8. No animals allowed in the pool enclosure.
- 9. The gate must be closed at all times. Propping the gate open is not per individuals without a pool pass.
- 10. No person with diarrhea illness or nausea should enter the pool.
- 11. No gum, glass, sharp objects or hazardous materials allowed in or aroun
- 12. No food or drinks allowed within five feet of the pool. No drinks in pool
- 13. No skateboards, bikes, roller blades, or similar are permitted in the pool
- 14. Bathers with open wounds, skin conditions, or any communicable condi-
- 15. Individuals should not swim alone.
- 16. Bathing attire must be worn at all times.
- 17. No spitting, spouting or blowing nose in pool.
- 18. Music should be enjoyed at low volumes in consideration of other guest
- 19. No running, jumping, or horseplay allowed on pool deck. No diving in ar
- 20. Improper behavior; e.g.; vulgar remarks, profanity, intoxication, indecen
- 21. Only one person is allowed on the slide at a time. The slide will only be guards are present.
- 22. Absolutely no standing, climbing up the slide, or inflatables are allowed
- 23. When no lifeguard is on duty, it's swim at your own risk.
- 24. NO ONE is allowed in any part of the pool during lifeguard breaks.
- You cannot 'Reserve' space. ie, bring items down to hold chairs or tables items at ALL TIMES.
