AGREEMENT OF THE APACHE CANYON
LAND OWNERS ASSOCIATION

MAY ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY EIGHT CENTS TWENTY FIVE MILLION DOLLARS

THE UNDERSIGNED, citizens of the State of New Mexico,
County of Santa Fe, and property owners as hereinafter
designated do hereby declare and certify as follows:

Land Owners Association, a non-profit association.

The objects and purposes of this association shall be
for the purpose of complying with the special use permit
granted by the Santa Fe National Forest, Tesuque District to
the owners of the lands composing this association, which
special use permit is for a roadway for access through forest
service lands into the lands of the members of the association,
which which is located in the town of Tesuque, New Mexico, and is
as follows:

The undersigned members agree and bind themselves to
comply with all of the terms and conditions and covenants
contained in the special use permit above-referred to, and they
bind themselves, their heirs, successors and assigns to comply
with the terms of the said special use permit as well as with
the conditions, obligations and covenants contained in this
agreement of the undersigned members of the association.

shall not cut any standing trees, that the only time a tree
would be cut off if it is charged with the duty of paying all
service for the improvement or maintenance of the roadway

who cuts any standing timber shall be subject to expulsion
from the association and the denial of the use of the said road

under the special use permit. The president of this
association shall have the power and authority to call meetings
at any time that is necessary for the conduct of the business
of this association and shall give notice to the members of the

association either in writing or by telephone as may be the most convenient.

The members are required to attend the meetings or to send a representative to the said meeting to act in their behalf with specific instructions as to what the decision of the member shall be.

It is necessary to present VIII. PERIODS FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE AND FEES.

The members of the association shall share equally in the costs of maintenance of the road and any other matters reasonably required, to be done for the benefit of the association and the use of the said road under the special use permit, and all parties shall pay the sums to the president of the association so that he may cover expenses, including legal fees or any other matters that may be required reasonably promoting the purposes of this association.

The president shall maintain the records of the association and shall be charged with the duty of paying all expenses of the association. Each member of this association shall pay unto the president the sum chargeable as his share of any expense incurred in behalf of the association within Thirty (30) days of date of being advised of such charge. If any member fails to pay within the said Thirty (30) days, his privileges to the use of the road may be revoked by the association.

IX. EXPENSES

In incurring expenses in behalf of the association

the president shall advise the members of the association in a meeting called for such purpose so that they will be fully advised as to what may be necessary. A majority vote of the association is all that is necessary to conduct any of the business of this association. XIV

This agreement may be added to or amended by a vote of the president shall invite such person or persons as may be necessary to present proposals for road improvement or maintenance as may be required from time to time, and the president in the absence of any conference by the members of the association shall select a person or persons to do the work required for the maintenance or improvement of the roadway, the purpose being that the roadway shall be passable and usable to all properties of the members of this association at all times.

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ROAD MAINTENANCE

The initial members of this association shall be Roger Montgomery, Jim Marvol, Ann Marvol, Georgia Marvol, Kirk Aleck and Joe Roquillo all owners of properties to be served by the roadway which is the subject of the special use permit from the United States Forest Service. Other persons may become members of this association by becoming owners of lands serviced by the road subject of the special use permit herein referred to.

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This association is a non-profit association and no gain is to be anticipated by its members.
