

AREA PROFILE: BOLTON, CT

Bolton was founded in 1720, is a small rural town located a convenient 20 minutes away from both Hartford and the University of Connecticut. It is primarily residential, with a population of approximately 4,900 individuals and an economy primarily made up of small businesses. It's the destination of many day trips for outdoor and nature-oriented activities. With the tagline "A Town for All Season," the community is defined by its natural beauty and welcoming residents.

Conveniently located on I-384, US Route 44 and US Route 6, easy access is provided to all of New England and New York. Bolton's close proximity to the Hartford area provides numerous work, cultural and recreational activities. Historic Bolton center includes the Bolton Heritage Farm, the Congregational Church, the Town Hall, the Bentley Memorial Library and two greens. Several of these properties are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. They are part of the Washington-Rochambeau march to victory and encampment. Beautiful vistas can be seen from the trails through Bolton Heritage Farm.

Recreational opportunities abound in Bolton and the surrounding area. In addition to two state parks, Bolton has 3 town parks. Freja Park on US Route 44 offers various hiking trails. Herrick Park on Hebron Road has a community building, a playscape, baseball/softball fields, soccer field and basketball court. Located on Bolton Lake, Indian Notch Park is open during the summer months and has swimming, a picnic area and pavilion, a baseball field and basketball court.

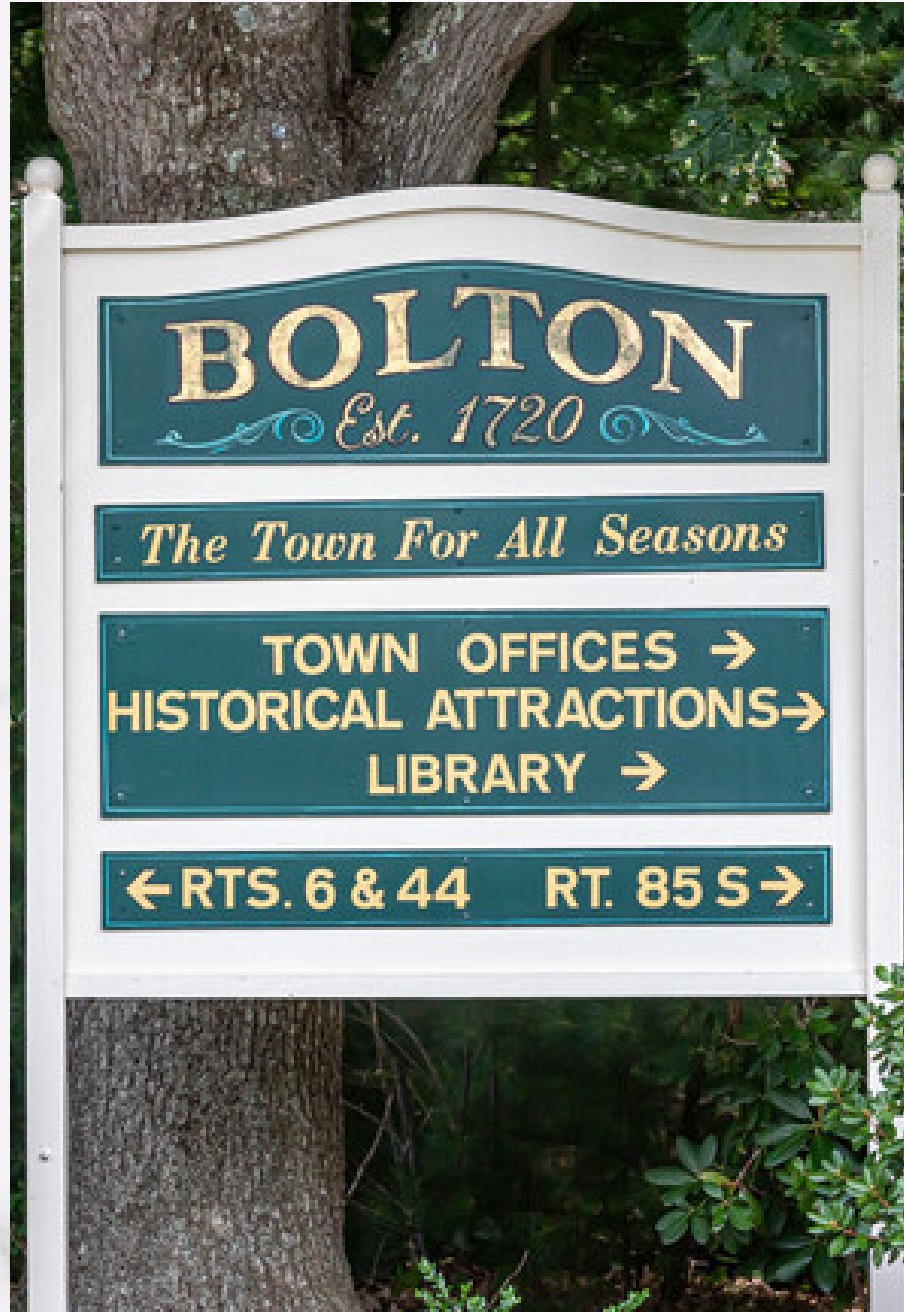
