Cherry Trees (4 varieties)

- Montmorency (1) – Tart, pie cherries
- Bing (1) – Sweet, dark red/black
- Lapins (1) – Sweet, red
- Van (1) – Needed for Bing to produce well

Pear Trees (4 varieties)

- Bartlett (1)
- Orcas (1) – Bartlett cultivar discovered on Orcas Island; larger and excellent fruit
- Anjou (1)
- Bosc (1) – Fall pear (located by cherry trees)

Plum Trees (2 varieties)

- Brooks (1) – August/September harvest
- Nichols (1) – Early harvest

Apple Trees (2 varieties in north area)

- Jonagold (1)

Fruit Trees – Backyard

- Almond Trees (2) – Just above pasture fence
 - Nikita's Pride
 - Oracle
- Apricot Tree (1) – Above almonds
 - Puget Gold
- Black Walnut Trees (2) – Above south almond
- Persimmon Trees (3) – Below blackberries
 - Nikita's Gift (hybrid)
 - Early Fuyu (Asian)
 - Prairie Sun (American)
- Peach Tree (1) – North of apricot
 - Oregon Curl-Free (Prunus persica, One Green World)

Berries

- Blackberries – Thornless (Triple Crown)
- Blueberries

Perennial Plants in Vegetable Garden

- Bay Leaf Tree (Laurus nobilis) – Survived 12°F in 2023
- Asparagus Bed – Large and very productive
- Thyme
- Sage
- Mint
- Oregano
- Rosemary
- Chives
- Artichokes – Short-lived; sometimes winter-killed
- Bunching Onions

Unusual / Ornamental Plants

- Dogwood (Cornus alternifolia 'Variegata') – "Wedding Cake Tree" (Gossler Nursery)
- Fragrant Fountain (Styrax japonica) – In front of parking area (Gossler Nursery)
- Himalayan White Birch Clump (3 trunks) – Treated annually by arborist (Kraemer Nursery)
- Lilacs (4) – Inside fence by Walnut (Hulda Klager Lilac Gardens, Woodland, WA)
 - Moskvyy (Krasavitsapint)
 - Sensation (yellow)
 - President Lincoln (blue)
 - Primrose (white)
- Eskimo Sunset Sycamore Maple (Acer pseudoplatanus) – East of lilacs (Gossler Nursery)
- Climbing Roses – Along east garden fence
 - Christine – Just north of bay leaf tree
 - Blaze – North end of garden fence
- Chief Joseph Pine – Needles turn bright yellow in winter (Gossler Nursery)
- Scarlet Oak (Quercus coccinea) – North of drive
- Ginkgo Biloba – Ancient species, "living fossil"
- Camellia 'Jury's Yellow' – Outside kitchen windows (north)
- Eucalyptus glaucescens – One Green World
