Property History & Development Timeline

- 1945: Property purchased by Jackson brothers.
- 1952: Jackson Reservoir dam constructed, securing water rights.
- Initial Crops: Potatoes and apples. A 6,000 sq. ft. Quonset Hut was built for processing.
- Later Use: The Quonset Hut was converted into a berry processing facility.
- 2005: Darrell Jackson takes over ownership.
 Apple orchard mostly removed; crop rotation began (wheat, peas, clover).
- 2016-2019:
 - Vineyard planted: 7 acres total of Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris
 - Full trellis and irrigation system installed by 2021
- 2021: First wine grape harvest, sold to Wine by Joe winery
- 2019: 820 McDonald hazelnut trees planted across 9 acres
- 2024: First hazelnut harvest; Winery facility approved and used by Adega Northwest

Current Agricultural Use

Vineyard (25 acres total)

- Planted Varieties: Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Syrah, Viognier
- Fully leased to an established vineyard operator

Hazelnut Orchard (9 acres)

- Variety: McDonald High-yield, high-value
- First harvest in 2024
- Long-term potential for increasing annual vields

Quonset Hut Winery (6,000 sq. ft.)
