Where Championship Golf Meets Community...



Nestled in Kennesaw, Georgia, Pinetree Country Club has been a beloved fixture of Northwest Atlanta's private club scene since 1962. Just 20 minutes from the perimeter, we're one of the most conveniently located private clubs for those on the northwest side of the city.

Our championship golf course - originally designed by Charles "Chick" Adams and masterfully renovated by Bill Berginin 2008 - stretches to 7,000 yards and plays to a course rating of 75 with a slope of 146. Don't let the parkland setting fool you: golfers who've played here know Pinetree is "sneaky good," with some of the finest Champion Bermuda greens in the Atlanta metro. The course has proudly hosted the Georgia State Amateur Championship multiple times, most recently in 2013.



Beyond golf, Pinetree is a true community. Our Men's Golf Association is among the most active in the region, and we're home to one of Atlanta's largest communities of scratch and plus-handicap players - making it a destination for serious competitors and passionate golfers alike. The Pinetree Ladies Golf Association (PLGA) is equally vibrant, welcoming golfers of all skill levels into a warm and competitive community centered on fellowship, sportsmanship, and a love of the game. The PLGA hosts monthly tournaments throughout the season and has produced some of Georgia's most decorated women's amateur players.

When you're ready to step off the course, enjoy four tennis courts, six pickleball courts, and a full Olympic swimming pool - amenities that make Pinetree a gathering place for the whole family, all season long!

THE HISTORY

Originally opened in October 1960 as the O.B. Keeler Memorial Golf Course, the club celebrated its grand opening by welcoming two of golf's legends, Arnold Palmer and Sam Snead. A few years later, the name was changed to Pinetree Country Club, beginning the tradition and legacy that continue to define the club today.

Over the years, Pinetree has welcomed many of the game's most respected figures, including Bobby Jones and Tommy Aaron. The club also played an early role in the career of Larry Nelson, a Kennesaw native who worked as a golf assistant at Pinetree before going on to a Hall of Fame career that included victories at the U.S. Open and two PGA Championship titles.

Pinetree's reputation as a championship venue has been reinforced through its selection to host some of Georgia's most prestigious tournaments. The club has hosted the Georgia State Amateur Championship in 1976, 1985, 2003, and again in 2013. It has also welcomed the Georgia Open in 2014 and the Atlanta Open in 2026, in addition to serving as a qualifying site for numerous Georgia and U.S. Amateur Championships.

Just as meaningful is the legacy found within the membership itself. Pinetree is proud to be home to four members of the Georgia Golf Hall of Fame. Their accomplishments reflect not only individual excellence but also the enduring tradition of championship golf that continues to define the club.

In 2007, with a commitment to preserving that tradition while preparing the course for the future, the membership undertook a comprehensive renovation. Architect Bill Bergin was selected to lead the project with the goal of maintaining the course's original character while thoughtfully improving each hole. Construction began in mid-2007, and the course reopened in October 2008 to enthusiastic reviews from the membership, with many feeling the results exceeded expectations.

THE POOL



The pool at Pinetree Country Club is a beloved centerpiece of the summer season and a vibrant hub for family fun, relaxation, and social events. Anchored by a large Olympic-sized swimming pool, the facility offers nine designated lap lanes for fitness swimming, three diving boards for spirited play, and a recently added splash pool that's perfect for younger children, all under the watchful supervision of trained lifeguards to ensure a safe environment for all ages.

Around the water, members can unwind in spacious sunning areas and enjoy the convenience of a beautiful cabana bar and poolside service featuring refreshing beverages and delicious lunches. The pool complements an active social calendar with festive events throughout the warm months - from a Memorial Day Carnival to a spectacular Fourth of July barbecue and fireworks to name a few!



RACQUET SPORTS

GOLF ASSOCIATIONS

MEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION (MGA)

The Pinetree Men's Golf Association is one of the best ways to meet fellow members and get plugged into the club community. The MGA hosts eight weekend tournaments throughout the year using a variety of formats and team structures, with events running from February through November - including fan favorites like The Masters, The Yank, The Silver Cup, and the MGA Championship. Tournament entry fees typically cover breakfast, lunch, and prizes awarded as shop credit.



The heartbeat of the MGA is the Thursday Night Scramble, a blind draw event held every Thursday during daylight savings time. Each week you're paired with different members, making it one of the fastest ways to build friendships and feel at home at Pinetree. The MGA also runs year-round match play competitions in putting, chipping, and net and gross formats with brackets of 32 to 64 players. Annual dues are \$100. To join, simply contact the main office or sign up when finalizing your membership.

LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION (LGA)

The Pinetree Ladies Golf Association welcomes golfers of every experience level - from seasoned competitors to complete beginners. Competitive 18-hole players enjoy weekly rounds on Tuesday and Thursday mornings, including the popular Tuesday "Ball Toss" play day where teams are drawn and two best ball net format is played. The 9+9 group offers a relaxed mix of competitive and social play on Tuesday and Thursday mornings, and often gathers in the grill for lunch after the round.

Beginners are warmly welcomed, with a dedicated group that meets Wednesday and Thursday mornings on the driving range and putting greens before heading in for lunch together. When a beginner feels ready for course play, the 9+9 group is happy to bring her right into the fold.



The PLGA hosts a full tournament schedule throughout the year, including the Spring and Fall two-day tournaments, two Member/Guest events, the Turkey Shoot, the Silver Cup, and a beloved Christmas Luncheon where annual awards are presented. Annual dues are \$50 and, upon joining, simply contact the main office to sign up.

TEE TIME AVAILABILITY

Tee Times may be made starting at 7:00am seven days prior to play for all golfing Memberships.

Times may be made by calling the golf shop at 770.428.0553.

Exclusion: For Holidays and Weekends, Sporting & Tennis Memberships may not make tee times until 12pm of the Thursday prior

GROUP PLAY

Pinetree does have various groups that play throughout the week. These groups have times pre-booked on the tee sheet. Sign ups are taken through golf genius. At 2:00pm, five days prior to play, any times not utilized by the group will be released.

Our groups range from scratch golfers to high handicaps, younger Members to older, and everything in between. New Members are encouraged to participate in various events such Thursday Night Scrambles, Couples Golf, and MGA/LGA Events. These are great ways to meet other Members and potentially join one of our various groups.

WAITING LIST

Very often the golf shop will start a waiting list for those Members that call before group play times are opened. Once the times are confirmed for various group play, the golf shop will work through the waiting list to accommodate as many Members as possible.

CANCELLATIONS / NO-SHOWS

Members must cancel tee times the day prior to avoid a no-show penalty. This will also allow the golf shop time to accommodate any Members on the waiting list. Failure to cancel before the day prior will result in the group being marked as a 'no-show'. Multiple 'no-shows' may result in a penalty and suspension of tee time privileges.

TOURNAMENTS

Pinetree has both a Men's & Ladies Golf Association. Both groups have approximately one tournament a month. New Members are encouraged to join either Association as both are great ways to meet other Members.

Along with the MGA & LGA, the Club will run Club Championships as well as the Men's Member Guest Tournament each year.
