INFORMATION TO TAXPAYERS

Payment Options

- 1) **Payment by Mail** – Check made payable to: **City of Portsmouth**, and mailed to:

Tax Collector, City of Portsmouth

Portsmouth, NH 03802-4507

If you would like a receipt, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

- 2) **Payment Online** – Go to: www.portsmouthnh.gov then select ‘Pay My Bill’. Payments will be posted to your account within two business days.
- By ACH or E-check from your checking or savings account – **No Fee**
 - By credit/debit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or VISA) – **2.95% convenience fee** or \$1.95 minimum fee applies.**
- 3) **Payment by Phone** – 1-844-850-9185. **\$1.50 phone fee applies. In addition, 2.95% service fee applies to credit/debit card payments.**
- 4) **In-Person Payment at City Hall** - Check, Cash, or Credit Card. A **2.95% service fee or \$1.95 minimum fee applies to credit/debit card payments.**
- 5) **Drop Box in City Hall Parking Lot** – Checks only, along with bill stub, may be placed in the drop box.

*** The city does not retain card processing fees; they are charged and collected by a third-party payment processor. ***

Late Payment of Taxes

- 8% interest will accrue on the unpaid balance after the due date.
- Payments will be applied to any accrued interest and fees first.
- Liens are placed on unpaid balances within 90 days of the June due date – costs and 14% interest apply.
- The taxpayer has two years to redeem the lien before the deeding process begins.

Exemptions, Tax Credits & Deferrals Available

If you are elderly, disabled, blind, a veteran, or veteran’s spouse, or are unable to pay taxes due to poverty or other good cause, you may be eligible for a tax exemption, credit, abatement, or deferral. For details and application information, contact the Assessor’s Office.

- **Elderly & Disabled Exemptions** - Taxpayers who qualify based on age or Social Security disability, residency and financial status may receive an exemption from the assessed value. Deadline to apply is April 15 preceding the setting of the tax rate.
- **Blind & Solar Exemptions** - Taxpayers who are blind or who own a solar energy system may receive an exemption from the assessed value. Deadline to apply is April 15 preceding the setting of the tax rate.
- **Veterans’ Tax Credits** - Taxpayers may receive a tax credit if they are a veteran, a service-connected permanently and totally disabled veteran, a spouse or surviving spouse of a veteran. The deadline to apply is April 15, preceding the setting of the tax rate.
- **Elderly & Disabled Tax Deferrals** - Taxpayers may defer all or part of their taxes due based on age or disability and residency. Deadline to apply is March 1 following the December tax bill.

Filing an Abatement Request

Any person aggrieved by their assessment may apply in writing on an abatement application form which can be located on the City’s Assessor’s webpage or at the Assessor’s Office. Applications are **due no later than March 1** following the date of notice of tax.

*** Filing for an abatement, credit, deferral, or exemption does not affect due dates – to avoid interest, taxes must be paid by the due date. ***
